Insight Days and Virtual Work Experience

Discovery Workshops are 1-2 hour career talks by employers giving an insight into their business and sector. Each workshop meets Gatsby Benchmark 5. To book a discovery workshop, teachers can register for a whole class or year group and the session can be streamed into a classroom. There is often a Q&A opportunity with the employer during the session

Insight Days are usually full or half day opportunities where students can engage with employers. For these opportunities, students apply individually via the portal and access the session through their own device. This includes Twilight Sessions.

Virtual Work Experience opportunities are placements, usually lasting a few days, that are applied for by students individually via the portal and accessed through their own devices. Teachers can share our placement opportunities with their students.
